Mahim Khan v Alkiviades David **Claim No. KB-2025-001991**

1. We write regarding your emails sent to us dated 11 August 2025 and timed at 20:53, 21:13, 21:23 and 21:28.
2. We have already set out our position regarding the alleged assault in our letter to you dated 11 August 2025.
3. We note that your allegations have evolved as you now state that the alleged assault occurred in open court and in the presence of June Morgan, the Clerk to Mr. Justice Cotter, Boniswa Dzere and Ms. Hume. This statement is false. As you are aware the allegations relate to service of the Contempt Application on you which occurred outside Court 11 and not in the presence of these individuals who were inside Court 11 at the time of the alleged incident.
4. Mr. Justice Cotter has already advised you that any criminal allegations are a matter for the police and not these proceedings which are civil, not criminal proceedings. As previously stated, we have received no contact from the police.
5. There has been no abuse, psychological harm, prejudice or discrimination inflicted upon you by any members of this firm or the Claimant in connection with your disability. You will recall that during the hearing on 25 July 2025, Mr. Justice Cotter spent a significant amount of time discussing your disability with you at the outset of the hearing. By your own admission, you recognised the effects of your brain injury. The result of this was that in his judgment, Mr. Justice Cotter considered your vulnerabilities and difficulties in these proceedings and determined that you had capacity and that the proceedings should continue. He also explained to you the steps you should take in connection with making any applications and ordered an adjournment of the Contempt Application to enable you to comply with paragraphs 9 and 10



of the Freezing Orders. At all times, the Claimant has acted in accordance with the orders made in these proceedings and court rules and practice.
