Application for Charging Order

We write to inform you that our client filed with the court an application for a Charging Order on 5 November 2025 in connection with the judgment in default entered against you on 18 July 2025 ("**Charging Order Application**").

An Interim Charging Order has been granted by Senior Master Cook dated 11 February 2026 in connection with the property known as 4 Wilton Place, London, SW1X 8RH (registered at HM Land Registry with title numbers NGL948717 and NGL3978690) ("**Interim Order**"). Please note that this firm only received the Interim Order from the Court on 20 March 2026. For that reason, we have not been able to serve the Interim Order previously because: (i) there was insufficient time to serve the order by the hearing date (7 April 2026) stipulated at paragraph 2 of the Interim Order (the service provisions in CPR Rule 73.7(5) require us to serve the Charging Order Application, Interim Order and supporting documents not less than 21 day before the hearing); and (ii) the date of the court's seal on the Interim Order was incorrect.

In relation to point (i) above, the court has subsequently granted an Adjournment Order dated 24 March 2026 ("**Adjournment Order**"). Paragraph 1 of the Adjournment Order adjourns the hearing which was listed on 7 April 2026 (referred to at paragraph 2 of the Interim Order) to the first available date after 28 April 2026. The reason for this is recorded in third recital of the Adjournment Order.

In relation to point (ii) above, the court has now corrected the date of the seal to 11 February 2026.

Accordingly, in accordance with CPR Rule 73.7(5), we enclose by way of service upon you, the following documents, which we are required to serve on you not less than 21 days before the hearing, which we are serving now notwithstanding that the adjourned hearing is yet to be listed:

1. The Interim Order;



2. The Adjournment Order; and
3. The Charging Order Application (together with enclosures).

Please note that we have not yet received a sealed copy of the Charging Order Application from the court which we will provide when it becomes available.

Next steps

We should be grateful if you would acknowledge service of the above documents.

We will write to you further once the Charging Order Application has been listed for a hearing at which the court will determine whether the Interim Order should be made final.
