FURTHER SUBMISSION ON MISREPRESENTATION AND PRIOR NOTICE

Howard Kennedy LLP had prior and repeated notice of the Antigua proceedings through service attempts acknowledged in October 2025 and completed service in England in December 2025. Howard Kennedy LLP falsely represented to this Court that the Claimant exhausted appeals to the Supreme Court of the United States. No such appeal occurred and the U.S. matter never left the California civil appellate circuit. These inaccuracies materially affect credibility and jurisdictional considerations.

FURTHER COURT NOTE – PARALLEL ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS (ENGLAND)

(TPDO Proceedings – Claim No. KB-2025-001991)

On 19 January 2026, Senior Master Cook adjourned the Third Party Debt Order proceedings in England. Howard Kennedy LLP are the solicitors on record pursuing enforcement arising from the same U.S. judgment relied upon by Defendants.

FURTHER EVIDENTIAL NOTICE – HOWARD KENNEDY LLP ENFORCEMENT ROLE

Filed by the Claimant, a disabled litigant in person, to place before this Court the sealed Order of the High Court of Justice (England & Wales) dated 19 January 2026 in Claim KB-2025-001991. That Order confirms Howard Kennedy LLP were formally served as solicitors in English enforcement proceedings arising from the identical U.S. judgment. This directly contradicts Howard Kennedy's 7 January 2026 representations to this Court claiming lack of involvement and lack of notice. The English Court's service of sealed enforcement orders upon Howard Kennedy LLP establishes their material participation in the enforcement chain and prior procedural knowledge.
