## **APPELLANT'S NOTICE OF FURTHER SUPPLEMENTAL MATTERS AND PROCEDURAL DEVELOPMENTS**

### **I. INTRODUCTION**

Appellant Alkiviades David, appearing in propria persona, respectfully submits this Notice to advise the Court of the present procedural posture of these consolidated appeals, specifically:

- 1 Respondent's continued default in filing a Respondent's Brief following this Court's Notice of Default issued on March 17, 2026;
- 2 The existence of parallel proceedings in other jurisdictions involving overlapping parties and related subject matter.

This Notice is submitted solely for informational purposes. It does not seek to augment the record, present new evidence, or request substantive relief.

### **II. RESPONDENT'S CONTINUED DEFAULT**

On March 17, 2026, this Court issued a Notice of Default pursuant to California Rules of Court, rule 8.220(a). Respondent has not cured that default by filing a Respondent's Brief, nor has Respondent sought relief from default or requested an extension of time.

Accordingly, under rule 8.220(a)(2), these consolidated appeals are now positioned for submission and decision on the record and Appellant's Opening Brief.

### **III. PARALLEL PROCEEDINGS**

Appellant is also a party to proceedings in other jurisdictions involving overlapping parties and related issues concerning litigation conduct and enforcement. Those proceedings include:

- 1 High Court of Justice, Antigua and Barbuda, Claim No. ANUHCV2025/0149;
- 2 Related enforcement proceedings in the High Court of Justice of England and Wales (King's Bench Division), in which a Third Party Debt Order application was adjourned by Order dated March 20, 2026, to a date after June 18, 2026.

This information is provided only for contextual awareness. Appellant does not request that this Court determine any matter pending in another jurisdiction.

#### **IV. ADDITIONAL PROCEDURAL CONTEXT**

Appellant is self-represented and has a documented disability. Matters relating to disability accommodations and disruption of prior legal representation were raised in the trial court and are reflected in the record on appeal. This is noted only as limited procedural background relevant to fairness and access under California Rules of Court, rule 1.100.
