NOTE TO THE CLERK

I am the Appellant, appearing in propria persona and fully associated in this appeal. Because March 31, 2026 is Cesar Chavez Day, a court holiday, and because my documented traumatic brain injury materially affects my ability to manage filing timing and procedural logistics, I respectfully request reasonable assistance and accommodation in the processing of this submission. I am filing this Supplemental Notice today in good faith to ensure meaningful access under the ADA and proper presentation of the current procedural posture. I respectfully ask that the Court accept and file this submission.

I. INTRODUCTION

Appellant Alkiviades David, appearing in propria persona and as a qualified individual with a disability, namely traumatic brain injury ("TBI"), respectfully submits this Supplemental Notice to notify the Court of Respondent's default, request submission under Rule 8.220, request ADA accommodations, and provide notice of structural irregularities.

II. RESPONDENT'S DEFAULT

The 15-day cure period expired April 1, 2026. Respondent has not filed a brief.

REQUEST:

Deem the appeal submitted and proceed to decision.

III. ADA ACCOMMODATION REQUEST

Appellant is a qualified individual with a disability under the ADA and Section 504. For more than a decade, Appellant has lived with a documented traumatic brain injury that has inflicted profound neurological damage, including cognitive limitations, memory deficits, and fatigue affecting litigation capacity.

Over many years, Appellant has experienced repeated procedural disadvantages related to this condition, including lack of accommodation, impaired participation, and difficulty navigating complex proceedings.

Requested accommodations include liberal construction of filings, acceptance of good-faith procedural efforts, reasonable clerk assistance, and clear communication.

IV. STRUCTURAL IRREGULARITIES

The record reflects lack of meaningful participation, one-sided evidence, and due process concerns requiring appellate review.

V. REQUEST FOR RELIEF

Appellant requests submission of the appeal, acceptance of this notice, ADA accommodations, and consideration of structural issues.

VI. CONCLUSION

This filing is made in good faith to ensure fair access to justice.
