## SUPPLEMENTAL ADDENDUM

Dated: 15 February 2026

1. This Addendum places before the Court fresh procedural developments in parallel proceedings in the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court (Antigua and Barbuda), Claim No. ANUHCV2025/0149.
2. On 3 February 2026, the Appellant filed a Notice of Factual Clarification and a Notice of Contempt, both court-stamped and forming part of the official Antigua record.
3. Sworn Statements of Service dated 12 December 2025 were filed confirming service upon named defendants, including parties connected to the present UK proceedings.
4. No acknowledgment of service, defence, or appearance has been filed in the Antigua proceedings as of the date of this Addendum.
5. Registry indications confirm that case management directions concerning default judgment are imminent.
6. The Appellant relies upon these developments in accordance with the principles in *Ladd v Marshall*: (i) the material was not available at the time of the decision below; (ii) it is capable of influencing forum and comity analysis; (iii) it consists of credible court-stamped filings and sworn statements.
7. The Appellant is a disabled litigant in person suffering from traumatic brain injury and respectfully seeks reasonable procedural consideration.
8. Relief sought: (a) Permission to adduce the fresh evidence; (b) Permission to file concise supplemental submissions limited to comity and procedural posture; (c) Such further directions as the Court considers appropriate.
