SUPPLEMENTAL ADDENDUM

1. This Addendum is filed to place before the Court fresh procedural developments arising in parallel proceedings before the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court (Claim No. ANUHCV2025/0149).
2. On 3 February 2026, the Appellant filed two court-stamped notices (Exhibits AD-3 and AD-4). As of today's date, no Defendant has filed acknowledgment of service, defence, or appearance in those proceedings.
3. The Appellant respectfully submits that these developments satisfy the test in *Ladd v Marshall*:
 - (a) The evidence did not exist at the time of the decision below;
 - (b) The evidence is material to forum coherence, comity, and procedural posture;
 - (c) The evidence is credible and formally court-stamped.
4. The present matter (KB-2025-001991) was previously listed before Barry Cotter J in the King's Bench Division. The Appellant's jurisdictional submissions were placed on record. This reference is made solely to confirm procedural continuity.
5. The Appellant is a disabled litigant in person and respectfully reiterates his request that reasonable procedural consideration be afforded in accordance with applicable access-to-justice principles.

Relief Sought:

Permission to adduce the fresh material and to make concise supplemental submissions limited to comity and procedural posture.
