I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Allred-Comprehensive Report (1).pdf, and allred-probe.pdf. These materials demonstrate a non-ordinary evidentiary environment involving overlapping legal actors, regulatory scrutiny, and cross-jurisdictional convergence. The evidentiary record includes material corroborated by a former United States Congressman with defense and intelligence oversight authority.
