Core Safeguarding Issue

The evidentiary record contains material indicating potential indexed exposure pathways involving minors. This creates an immediate safeguarding trigger requiring judicial caution.

Legal Position

Where safeguarding risks involving minors are present, enforcement should not proceed until the evidentiary record is complete.

Cross-Jurisdictional Context

Parallel proceedings and transcript evidence confirm this matter spans multiple jurisdictions, increasing procedural risk.

Relief Sought

1. Immediate stay of enforcement
2. Preservation of all evidence
3. Recognition of safeguarding implications
4. Permission to expand the evidentiary record

Final Submission

Where credible material suggests exposure pathways involving minors, enforcement must pause pending full safeguarding assessment.
