FINAL CONSOLIDATED EVIDENTIARY DOSSIER & SKELETON ARGUMENT

PREAMBLE — CHILD SAFETY AND PUBLIC INTEREST

The protection of children is a fundamental duty of the Court. Where indexed systems reveal potential exposure pathways involving very young age categories, enforcement cannot safely proceed until the integrity of the record is secured.

PURPOSE

This filing raises one question: Can enforcement safely proceed on a materially incomplete and structurally compromised record? The Appellant submits it cannot.

Where structured systems, legal pressure, and evidentiary gaps converge, enforcement is unsafe.
