IX. CROSS-JURISDICTIONAL OVERLAP Parallel proceedings in Antigua (ANUHCV2025/0149) involve overlapping parties and subject matter.

X. CONSISTENCY OF ACTORS The Antigua claim identifies substantially overlapping actors, including attorneys and entities also connected to the proceedings below ■filecite■turn12file0■.
