I acknowledge that I have now overstayed my visa by approximately three months. This has not been intentional or in disregard of the law. I have, at all times prior, complied with immigration requirements, including extending my stay where required. My current position has arisen due to a combination of exceptional and interrelated circumstances. First, I am presently engaged in ongoing High Court proceedings in Antigua and Barbuda (Claim No. ANUHCV2025/0149), in which I am acting as a litigant in person. Second, I am a severely disabled individual and am supported by my wife, Shiley Hinton-David, who assists me daily. Third, I am responsible for the care of over 100 rescued animals and cannot abandon their welfare. Fourth, I maintain an ongoing position in relation to citizenship under the CIP framework, which includes my family. I respectfully request: 1. The regularisation of my current overstay; and 2. A short extension of stay to conclude my legal matters and maintain my responsibilities. I remain committed to full compliance with the laws of Antigua and Barbuda. Yours faithfully, Alkiviades A.
