

IN THE HIGH COURT OF JUSTICE KING'S BENCH DIVISION

URGENT CASE MANAGEMENT NOTE (FOR THE COURT)

This submission raises matters that are the subject of active and ongoing complaints to competent law enforcement authorities, including the Criminal Investigations Department (CID) in Antigua and Barbuda and other agencies in parallel jurisdictions.

The Appellant does not invite this Court to determine any criminal issues. However, the existence of such investigations, and the underlying evidential concerns relating to record integrity and coordinated conduct, are directly relevant to the safety of enforcement and the fairness of continuing proceedings at this stage.

In those circumstances, the Appellant respectfully submits that proceeding to enforcement without allowing those matters to be clarified would carry a real risk of procedural injustice, and invites the Court to exercise caution through its case management powers.
