1. Executive Summary

This report presents a structured criminal complaint and evidentiary briefing requiring immediate CID attention. The material outlines cross-jurisdictional indicators of obstruction of justice, evidence tampering, and abuse of process.

2. Immediate Requests

Open a formal CID investigation.
Preserve all court and Attorney General's Chambers records.
Identify and interview all named individuals.
Prepare for INTERPOL escalation if required.

3. Antigua Anchor – ANUHCV2025/0149

The case forms the central investigative anchor.
Events surrounding the 16 January 2026 hearing raise concerns regarding procedural integrity.

4. Circular Deflection Pattern

AG Chambers → Mr Phillip → Court → Registry → AG Chambers
This pattern suggests possible displacement of responsibility or record interference.
