**Subject:** Request for Investigation Into Solicitor Misconduct Affecting My Capacity as a Disabled Litigant

Dear Ms. Price,

I write to provide further evidence in support of my ongoing complaint and to request that the SRA investigate the conduct of solicitor **Mr. Hume**, whose actions materially affected my ability to participate fairly in *Mahim Khan v. David* (£54 million) and related UK proceedings.

All statements herein are confined to **documented facts, court-record events, sworn filings**, and matters within the SRA's regulatory r

### 1. My Disability and the Duty to Protect a Vulnerable Client

I have medically documented **traumatic brain injury (TBI)** and associated cognitive vulnerabilities. These are confirmed by:

- MRI-based findings from Dr. Eric Wexler
- A Greek forensic psychiatric report confirming intact reality testing despite impairment

As a vulnerable client, I was entitled to enhanced protection, support, and the safeguarding duties solicitors owe under SRA regulations.

### 2. Psychiatric Referral by Solicitor Fred Heather to Dr. Eric Wexler

While representing me in both the Mahim Khan and Jane Doe matters, **Mr. Heather** referred me to psychiatrist **Dr. Eric Wexler**.

Dr. Wexler's treatment plan involved multiple psychiatric drugs **contraindicated for TBI**, presenting foreseeable risks of:

- cognitive impairment
- reduced executive function
- loss of litigation capacity

The plan arrived during active litigation and would have impaired my ability to instruct counsel or participate in proceedings.

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
