Dear Sir/Madam,

I write to formally submit my Voluntary Statement to the Criminal Investigations Department and to respectfully request that an investigation be opened into matters arising from High Court proceedings in Antigua and Barbuda (Claim No. ANUHCV2025/0149).

I am presently in Antigua and Barbuda as a British citizen and principal of SwissX Island, with ongoing investments under the Citizenship by Investment Programme. I acknowledge that I have overstayed my permitted period of entry by approximately three months. This has arisen solely due to the necessity of my continued presence in the jurisdiction to manage active High Court proceedings, protect substantial assets, and advance my CIP application. A formal request for regularisation of stay has been submitted today, and I remain fully compliant and available to authorities at all times.

I respectfully request that CID investigate whether criminal conduct has occurred in relation to:

1. Possible alteration of court records
2. Non-compliance with court process
3. Threats, intimidation, or attempted intrusion
4. Associated conduct affecting proceedings

These matters arise within a broader cross-border context involving Antigua, the United Kingdom, and the United States. I respectfully invite CID to consider liaison with relevant UK authorities where appropriate.

I have prepared a full Voluntary Statement together with a structured exhibit bundle including court records, filings, transcripts, and supporting communications.

I respectfully request that CID open an investigation, secure and review relevant records, examine the evidence, and determine whether any offences have been committed.

I will attend CID in person and remain fully cooperative.
