### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This dossier constitutes a formal criminal complaint and multi-jurisdictional evidence submission. It establishes reasonable grounds to investigate interference with judicial processes.

Evidence demonstrates coordinated conduct across Antigua, UK, and USA affecting due process.

### ANTIGUA FOUNDATION

Claim ANUHCV2025/0149 – defaults recognized; post-hearing irregularities observed.

### UK DIMENSION

Includes enforcement proceedings and alleged courtroom incident with witnesses.

### MEDICAL EVIDENCE

Conflict between Wexler report and Greek evaluation raises concern of inconsistent use.

### WITNESSES

Daniel Kapon Jr. and Alison Doe provide corroborating pattern evidence.

### INTERNATIONAL REQUEST

Request referral via NCB Antigua for INTERPOL coordination and MLA pathways.
