



SWISSX GLOBAL DOSSIER – VERSION 3 (FULL ESCALATION)

EXECUTIVE POSITION

This dossier consolidates multiple strands of alleged misconduct across jurisdictions and is submitted as a coordinated escalation for investigation. The matters outlined involve potential criminal exposure spanning media systems, legal processes, and cross-border financial activity.

NETWORK STRUCTURE (SUBJECTS OF INVESTIGATION)

The following individuals and entities are identified as subjects requiring investigative review in connection with the allegations described: media platforms, legal representatives, enforcement intermediaries, and associated facilitators operating across the United States, United Kingdom, and Caribbean jurisdictions.

SYNCHRONIZED LEGAL TIMELINE

United States: Appellate proceedings and procedural defaults currently active. United Kingdom: Appeal and enforcement considerations ongoing. Antigua & Barbuda: Default positions and alleged interference under review. These proceedings intersect and create a unified evidentiary timeline requiring coordinated assessment.

EVIDENCE FRAMEWORK

Supporting materials include affidavits, witness testimony, electronic communications, expert reports, and court filings. These materials are available for review and are referenced across jurisdictions.

INTERPOL ESCALATION BASIS

Given the transnational nature of the allegations, it is requested that authorities evaluate referral to INTERPOL mechanisms for coordination, including potential economic crime, trafficking-related inquiries, and obstruction of justice considerations.

NOTICE OF AWARENESS

Relevant authorities, institutions, and individuals receiving this dossier are now on formal notice of the allegations and supporting material. Failure to appropriately assess or act may create exposure to secondary liability where

knowledge and inaction are established.
