Cross-Jurisdictional Coordination Request and Evidence Preservation Notice

1. Purpose

This submission is provided to support:

- evidence preservation
- cross-agency coordination
- escalation awareness

across the following agencies:

- Metropolitan Police Service (UK)
- Federal Bureau of Investigation (USA)
- U.S. Department of Justice
- Dallas Police Department

2. Executive Alert

The consolidated record across proceedings in the United Kingdom, Antigua and Barbuda, and the United States reflects a recurring structural pattern in which legal action, reputational exposure, and enforcement pressure appear to operate in parallel before full adjudication.

This pattern raises legitimate investigative questions concerning:

- process integrity
- document consistency
- cross-border coordination
- potential witness risk

3. Critical Incident Context - Political Homicide

The record includes reporting that Asot Michael, a sitting political office holder in Antigua and Barbuda, was found deceased at his residence with multiple stab wounds. The matter remains the subject of an active homicide investigation.

Escalation relevance:

- the deceased was a political office holder
- the jurisdiction overlaps with an active litigation environment
- the timing is proximate to interactions referenced elsewhere in this brief

Important limitation

No attribution, conclusion, or allegation is made in this submission as to any perpetrator, motive, or causal connection between that homicide investigation and the matters referenced below.

4. Network Proximity and Associated Contact Layer

Available materials indicate overlapping proximity involving:

- Daphne Barak
- litigation participants across multiple jurisdictions
- referenced communication and meeting pathways

Operational significance: shared timelines, intersecting communications, and overlap among individuals appearing across separate legal and factual settings.

5. Expanded Network Context (Public-Domain Association Layer)

The record also references individuals who, in public, professional, or historical capacities, have operated within overlapping spheres of:

- high-value litigation
- political leadership
- entertainment and media governance
- international advisory and financial networks

Relevant individuals (contextual mapping only):

- David Boies

- John Branca
- Barack Obama
- Ehud Barak

Critical clarification

These individuals are referenced solely by reason of publicly known roles, professional positioning, or historical prominence. No allegation of wrongdoing is made against any of them in this submission.

Investigative relevance: to determine whether overlapping networks of influence, advisory roles, or legal positioning intersect with litigation pathways, financial exposure, or narrative formation.

6. Structural Control - Gatekeeper Function

A recurring structural feature reflected in the record is the presence of individuals positioned at key control points within systems of legal, financial, and reputational flow.

In that context, David Boies is noted as a repeated figure in high-value litigation environments across multiple referenced matters.

For the avoidance of doubt, the term "gatekeeper" is used here only as a structural descriptor for a node of influence or access. It is not used as evidence of misconduct.

7. Record Integrity Trigger Event (Antigua)

Materials reviewed indicate the removal of named defendants, described as the UPP executive group, in circumstances said to have direct jurisdictional impact.

This issue is documented in High Court filing records.

Escalation significance: if verified, this would constitute a material procedural anomaly requiring formal review, preservation, and clarification.

8. Multi-Jurisdictional Convergence

The record reflects linked systems involving:

- United Kingdom: enforcement and appeal proceedings
- Antigua and Barbuda: High Court proceedings and CID-related matters
- United States: civil and regulatory records

Concern: overlapping reliance on interconnected facts, actors, and pressures without a unified cross-jurisdictional review.

9. Financial Pressure Vector

Indicators reflected in the record include:

- enforcement activity during active appeal periods
- exposure of significant assets
- regulatory outcomes viewed as disproportionate in context

Interpretive concern: the possible use of financial mechanisms as leverage within unresolved legal processes.

10. Investigative Flags - Priority Review Areas

The principal review areas are:

- document integrity
- communication mapping
- timeline correlation
- witness linkage
- jurisdictional coordination

11. Core Threshold Question

The central threshold question raised by the present record is whether the observed pattern reflects:

- (a) entirely independent legal and administrative processes
- (b) structurally interconnected systems capable of influencing outcomes across jurisdictions

12. Request to Agencies

The undersigned respectfully requests:

- preservation of relevant records
- coordinated review across jurisdictions
- recognition of overlapping investigative relevance
- appropriate handling and protection of potentially vulnerable witnesses

13. Final Position

This submission:

- does not assert criminal liability
- does not allege wrongdoing by any named individual
- does not ask any agency to adopt a concluded theory of causation

Rather, it identifies a pattern of sufficient seriousness, repetition, and structural coherence to justify coordinated investigative awareness and evidence preservation.
