**SHORT REQUEST FOR DIRECTIONS ON JURISDICTION  
(WITH LIMITED EVIDENCE OF NOTICE)**

1. The Claimant respectfully seeks short directions limited to jurisdiction so that the proceedings may advance efficiently and with procedural certainty.
2. The Claimant requests that the Court indicate whether jurisdiction is engaged in respect of the United Progressive Party and its resident officers already identified on the record.

**NOTICE AND SERVICE CONTEXT (LIMITED)**

3. The Claimant notes that the Court already has before it evidence of formal service steps taken, allegations of actual notice, and public notice relied upon for procedural purposes.
4. For completeness, the Claimant files Exhibit A solely as evidence of public and constructive notice, including discoverability through indexed Google search results and public accessibility of service-related information.
5. The Claimant does not rely on Exhibit A as argument or proof of any pleaded fact, but only to demonstrate that notice of the proceedings was publicly available and discoverable in the ordinary course.

**PROCEDURAL EFFICIENCY**

6. The Claimant makes this request to clarify the jurisdictional footing of the proceedings, avoid unnecessary delay, and permit the Court to give appropriate further directions.
7. No substantive relief is sought beyond directions on jurisdiction and sequencing.

**DEFERENCE**

8. The Claimant defers entirely to the Court as to the weight (if any) to be given to Exhibit A and files it only to ensure the record is complete and accurate.
