



FORMAL CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

To: Royal Police Force of Antigua and Barbuda – Criminal Investigations Department

Complainant: Alkiviades A. David (Disabled Litigant in Person)

Respondent: Mr. Phillip, Attorney General's Chambers

1. Nature of Complaint

Suspected tampering with court records, interference with justice, threatening conduct, refusal by police to record a complaint, and disability-related prejudice.

2. Core Issue

Whether court documents in Claim No. ANUHCV2025/0149 were altered without authority, and whether reporting and enforcement were obstructed.

3. Prior Complaint

A complaint filed on 19 March 2026 was not formally recorded or assigned a report number.

4. Key Facts

- Baseline record established on 3 February 2026 via Notice of Factual Clarification.
- Subsequent discrepancies in court record.
- Circular referral: AG → Mr. Phillip (amicus) → Court → AG.
- No authority identified for changes.
- 5 February 2026: Threatening conduct at AG Chambers; police refused to take complaint.

5. Offences

Perverting the course of justice, obstruction, misconduct in public office, forgery/uttering, and police misconduct.

6. Requests

Record complaint, assign incident number, preserve court records, forensic comparison, identify responsible parties, review CCTV/logs, and confirm investigation.

7. Urgency

Court integrity is at risk and evidence may be lost.
