### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This complaint sets out allegations of evidence tampering, obstruction of justice, coordinated litigation targeting, and financial irregularities involving offshore activity across Antigua, the United Kingdom, and the United States.

### CORE ALLEGATIONS

- (A) Evidence tampering within Attorney General's Chambers (Mr Phillip)
- (B) Obstruction of justice in active proceedings
- (C) Coordinated litigation linked to Girardi Keese
- (D) Financial irregularities and offshore transfers
- (E) Cross-border coordination between UK, US, and Antigua proceedings

- 10 UCC filings not honoured
- 2 foreclosures
- Multiple offshore SWIFT transfers
