

V19 – JUDICIAL TRIGGER PAGE

CORE ISSUE: Whether enforcement can safely proceed on a materially incomplete evidentiary record.

- Intersections between media distribution, licensing, and litigation pathways
- Public-record precedent (NXIVM / Bronfman context)
- Indicators of structured, indexed illicit-content systems (redacted evidence)
- Potential gaps in evidentiary disclosure before the Court
