WITNESS STATEMENT OF ALKIVIADES DAVID

I am the Appellant and act as a litigant in person.

This statement supports my appeal concerning enforcement of a foreign judgment in England.

I do not challenge the merits of the California judgment.

My evidence addresses non-disclosure, missing evidence, fresh material, and medical impairment.

Material Non-Disclosure

Affidavits by Calendar and Shoefield existed but were not disclosed to the Court.

Failure of Evidence Presentation

Approximately 400 emails were not properly presented, resulting in an incomplete record.

Fresh Evidence

Rizzo communications were not available earlier and raise credibility issues.

Medical Condition

I suffer neurocognitive impairment affecting my ability to conduct proceedings.

Cumulative Effect

The Court did not have the full evidential picture. Enforcement is unsafe.
